

PORT LINCOLN GOLF CLUB INC RESULTS TO SAT 29Th APR 2017

Saturday April 29

95 players, including two from Whyalla, took to the links for a Stroke round, sponsored by Cafe Chinos. It was also Monthly Medal Day and the first qualifying round of the Fulwood Cup.

Of the 83 men, the Monthly Medals were won by Gavin Cheriton in A Grade with a par round of 72, Kane Williams in B Grade with 84 and Kevin Reidy in C Grade with 93.
